Riverwalk Bond Center Expansion to Unveil Renderings March 18th

Batavia, IL: Get ready to roll up your sleeves and get to work again, Batavia! Volunteers are ready to build community and make history at the Riverwalk this summer. The Batavia Parks Foundation and friends are launching a campaign to build a band shell and stage addition to the south end of the Peg Bond Center this year. The band shell expansion is the official community service project for the community during Batavia's 175th celebration of its founding. The project is due to get started in June and finish up by year's end, being built in 175 days.

The Batavia Parks Foundation unveils final renderings at the Batavia Park Board meeting on **Tuesday March 18th at the 7:30 p.m.** meeting at the Batavia Park District Civic Center (327 W Wilson St). Members of the foundation and key volunteers will be on hand after the presentation to answer questions about the project and will have a CD with rendering images for members of the press.
